2. By way of this petition, the petitioner has assailed the transfer order dated 30.06.2026 (Annexure P-1), in terms whereof, the petitioner, who is serving as a Lecturer in GSSS Dhulara, District Chamba, to GSSS Chah-Ka-Dohra, District Mandi.

3. Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that though the petitioner has completed his normal tenure at the present station but in light of the fact that he is to superannuate in less than two years, interest of justice would be served, in case, respondents are directed to decide the representation of the petitioner and if possible, to adjust him at a nearby station.

4. This Court is of the considered view that interest of

justice would be served, in case, petitioner approaches the Authority by way of a representation and the Authority takes a call on the said representation in light of the guidelines of the Transfer Policy.

5. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of with the direction that in the event of the petitioner approaching the Authority, by way of a representation for his adjustment within one week from today, appropriate orders be passed thereupon, as expeditiously as possible and definitely, in light of the transfer policy within a period of four weeks as from the date of receipt of the representation. Till decision on the representation, the petitioner will be allowed to serve at GSSS Dhulara, District Chamba *de hors* he stands relieved or not. This order is being passed by this Court as in terms of Annexure P-1, single transfer has been effected and none has been posted in place of the petitioner at GSSS Dhulara.

6. It goes without saying that in case the petitioner does not file appropriate representation within one week from today, then this order will lose its efficacy. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
