Notice. Mr. Rahul Thakur, learned Deputy Advocate General, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

The Court stands informed that the petitioner is 100% disabled on account of blindness. His grievance is that he has been called upon to vacate his current accommodation, i.e. Set No.4, Block No.4, Block No.1, Ellerslie, Shimla, as the respondents intend to carry out certain construction out over there without providing him with a suitable alternative.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has provided an alternate accommodation in Nabha, but the petitioner shall have to climb about 250 steps to reach said accommodation, which would be extremely difficult, with the kind of disability the the petitioner suffers.

Learned Deputy Advocate General submits that he may be granted a week's time to have instruction in the matter.

As prayed for, list on **23.07.2026**. The respondents to explore the possibility of providing some other suitable alternative accommodation to the petitioner in the meanwhile.
