

Surender Singh vs. State of Himachal Pradesh

This is an application for suspension of the sentence and releasing the appellant on bail. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the appellant that the appellant was on bail during the trial. The appeal already stands admitted. There are arguable points involved in the appeal. The hearing of the appeal will take some time. In these circumstances, the substantive sentence imposed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Special Court(Rape/POCSO) Sirmaur, District at Nahan, Himachal Pradesh, in Sessions trial No.9-ST/7 of 2021, titled **State of Himachal Pradesh versus Surender Singh and another**, on 19.06.2026, is suspended during the pendency of the appeal and the appellant is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing

personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (rupees fifty thousand only) with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court within a period of four weeks with the conditions that the appellant shall appear in the Court as and when directed and shall surrender to serve out the sentence imposed in case his appeal is ultimately dismissed. This order is further subject to the appellant depositing the entire amount of fine, if not already deposited, within a period of four weeks before the trial Court. The application stands disposed of.
