By way of instant petition filed under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, prayer has been made on behalf of the petitioner for quashing of FIR No.21 of 2022 dated 23.05.2022 under Sections 376 of Indian Penal Code read with Section 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Women Police Station Bhiuli, District Mandi, H.P., as well as consequent proceedings, if any, pending adjudication before the learned court below on the basis of amicable settlement arrived *inter se* parties.

Though compromise placed on record suggests that parties have resolved to settle the dispute amicably *inter se* them, but this Court with a view to ascertain the genuineness and correctness of the compromise placed on record, deems it fit to summon respondents No.4 for the next date of hearing so
