By way of present execution petition, prayer has been made by 3.7.2025, passed by this Court in CWP No.8171 of 2024, titled as Amit Kumar and Ors. *v. State of Himachal Pradesh and Ors.*, whereby afore petition came to be disposed of with a direction to respondents/competent authority to consider and decide representation of the petitioner in light of judgment dated 29.11.2024, passed by the coordinate Bench of this Court in CWP No. 1638 of 2024, titled as Mohit Sharma and Anr. *v. State of Himachal Pradesh and Ors.*, within a period of six weeks. Since no action, whatsoever, came to be taken at the behest of the respondents pursuant to

aforesaid direction, petitioner has approached this Court in the instant proceedings.

2. Mr. Rajan Kahol, learned Additional Advocate General appearing on behalf of the respondents, states that though he has every reason to presume and believe that by now, order/judgment sought to be executed, must have been complied with in its totality, but if not, same would be definitely complied with within a period of four weeks from today.

Consequently, in view of the fair stand adopted by the learned Additional Advocate General, this Court sees no reason to keep present petition alive and accordingly, same is disposed of with direction to the respondents to do the needful in terms of judgment alleged to have been violated within a period of four weeks, failing which petitioner would be at liberty to get the present petition revived so that appropriate action in accordance with law is taken towards implementation of the order/judgment.
