Heard. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner's grievance in this writ petition is confined to the respondents having issued office letter dated 10.10.2025 ordering recovery of an amount of ₹5,49,037/- from the petitioner allegedly paid in excess to him. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that aforesaid recovery has resulted on account of re-fixation of petitioner's pay carried out by the respondents. The petitioner is not aggrieved to re-fixation of his pay, however, he has grievance to the recovery ordered by the respondents and not only that said recovery is contrary to the principles well settled by law now but neither any show cause notice nor opportunity of being heard whatsoever was provided to the petitioner.

In view of the grievance of the petitioner and the documents placed on record, operation of Annexure P-1 dated

10.10.2025 to the extent it orders recovery of amount in question from the petitioner, shall remain stayed. The application stands disposed of.
