**CWP No. 18339 of 2025 and CMP No. 28275
of 2025**

Reference has been made to the pendency of CWP No. 17876 of 2025. It is submitted that in similar circumstances the petitioner was reallocated the shop on account of having been working alongwith the original allottee. Reference is made to the communication dated 28.11.2024, whereby regularization charges of ₹2,70,000/- were taken for shop No. 1 by the Municipal Corporation. It is submitted that the said respondent also wrote to the respondent No. 3 to hand over the possession of three newly constructed shops by showing the possession of Tikam Chand as 235 sq ft. Now the shops have been put to auction by a tender notice (Annexure P-5) and the tender process is to be done on 26.11.2025 (Annexure P-6).

In view of the controversy as such, we direct that shop No. 8, measuring 237.47 sq. ft., be not allotted to anybody in the auction/tender process.
