

Dishant Kumar Vs. Rakesh Kanwar & Anr.

Final opportunity was granted to the respondents to file compliance affidavit in the order dated 03.03.2026 as under: -

“Reply/compliance affidavit has not been filed despite grant of sufficient opportunity. At the request of learned Deputy Advocate General, two weeks’ further time, by way of final opportunity, is granted for the purpose. List thereafter.”

2. Neither reply nor compliance affidavit has been filed in terms of the decision rendered in CWP No. 6630/2021 (Dishant Kumar Vs. State & Ors.). The said petition filed by the petitioner, was allowed. Impugned order dated 07.07.2021 was set aside and respondents were directed to consider the case of the petitioner afresh for the purpose of regularization in light of the observations made in the decision and to pass appropriate order within a period of eight weeks. LPA No. 76/2025 filed by the respondents against the above decision was also dismissed on 23.05.2025. Despite this, the respondents have not implemented the judgment.

3. Learned Additional Advocate General submits that the respondents are contemplating preferring a Special Leave Petition against the aforesaid decision. Be that as it may, the fact remains that the judgment rendered on 04.04.2024, which was to be implemented within eight weeks, has still not been complied with; Almost a year has gone by, even after the dismissal of the above Letters Patent Appeal; Till date, there is no interim order, staying the operation of the decision dated 04.04.2024.

4. At the request of learned Additional Advocate General, yet another final opportunity of two weeks' is granted to the respondents to file compliance affidavit, subject to the cost of Rs.5,000/- to be paid to the petitioner on the next date. It is made clear, in case, the judgment in question is not implemented by the next date, respondents shall remain present in the Court.
