

Kashmir Singh vs. HRTC

Learned vice counsel for the respondent-Corporation has produced a copy of communication dated 05.05.2026, issued by the Divisional Manager, HRTC, D/W Mandi. The same is taken on record.

2. A perusal of the communication reveals that the amount due as on 10.02.2026 has not been paid to the petitioner.

3. Vide office order dated 09.10.2023, the claim preferred by the petitioner stands allowed in terms of the judgment passed by this Court in **CWP No.5126 of 2023**, titled, ***Kashmir Singh vs. Himachal Road Transport Corporation***. Once the judgment has been complied with to the extent of regularisation of the petitioner's services from the date of initial engagement on contract basis w.e.f. 09.05.2007 instead of 21.07.2014, the respondents are bound to extend the benefits emanating therefrom.

4. Learned vice counsel for the respondent prays for time to ascertain that why the amount of installment due on 10.02.2026 has not been released in favour of the petitioner.

5. Let the instructions be obtained and since as per own communication of the respondent dated 05.05.2026, Divisional Manager has mentioned due date, it is expected that the amount of 4th installment will be released in favour of the petitioner before the next date of hearing, failing which, the Managing Director of the respondent-Corporation shall remain present before the Court.
