By way of instant application, the petitioner is seeking suspension of substantive sentence imposed by Trial Court i.e. Learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Chopal, District Shimla (H.P.), in terms of the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 01.10.2024, passed in Complaint Case No. 156 of 2021, titled as Ravinder

Kumar Vs. Kirpa Ram Lepta and petitioner accused was directed to undergo Simple Imprisonment for six months and to pay compensation of Rs.6,00,000/ and in default of payment of compensation, to undergo further simple imprisonment for two months which stands affirmed on 12.11.2025 by the Appellate Court i.e. Learned Sessions Judge, Shimla, District Shimla (H.P.) in Cr. Appeal No.149-S/10 of 2024, titled as Kirpa Ram Vs. Ravinder Kumar.

3. Perusal of accompanying revision petition and submissions made by Learned Counsel for petitioner, indicate that the petitioner has an arguable case, for grant of interim protection, at this stage.

4. Accordingly, the substantive sentence imposed on the petitioner, in terms of the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 01.10.2024, passed in Complaint Case No. 156 of 2021, titled as Ravinder Kumar Vs. Kirpa Ram, which stands affirmed on 12.11.2025 by the Appellate Court i.e. Learned Sessions Judge, Shimla,

District Shimla (H.P.) in Cr. Appeal No. 149-S/10 of 2024, titled as Kirpa Ram Vs. Ravinder Kumar, shall remain suspended, during the pendency of the appeal, subject to the petitioner depositing 20% of total compensation amount [cheque amount and compensation thereon] and on furnishing a personal bond to the tune of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in like amount to the satisfaction of Learned Trial Court within six weeks from today.

List the matter, on reopening of Courts, after winter vacation in the week commencing from 23rd March, 2026.
