Cr.MP No.5844 of 2025

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in terms of order dated 29.12.2025, 20% of the compensation amount has been deposited, as such, afore order passed by this Court in Cr.MP No.5844 of 2025 is made absolute. Alteration, modification and vacation on motion. The application stands disposed of.

CR.R-727 of 2025

Mr. Sunil Chauhan, Advocate, has filed memo of appearance on behalf of respondent No.1. He prays for and is granted two weeks' time to file Power of Attorney.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner is ready and willing to pay the entire amount of compensation, provided he is given some reasonable time. He states that sum of Rs.4,40,000/- is lying deposited with the learned trial Court out of total sum of Rs.6,00,000/-. He states that remaining sum of Rs.1,60,000/- shall be deposited in two installments within six weeks.

Since petitioner is ready and willing to pay the entire amount of compensation, coupled with the fact that he has already deposited substantial amount, this Court sees no impediment in accepting the afore pryaer made on behalf of the petitioner and accordingly, it is ordered that sum of Rs.4,40,000/- lying deposited with the learned trial Court is ordered to be released in favour of the respondent/complainant by remitting the same in his bank account, detail whereof shall be furnished within one week.

Remaining sum of Rs.1,60,000/- shall be deposited in two installments within six weeks, failing which this Court shall have no option but to decide the petition on its own merits
