Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner, besides, furnishing bail bonds, has also deposited 50% of the compensation amount in terms of order dated 23.02.2026, as such, afore order is made absolute. He states that petitioner is ready and willing to deposit the remaining amount, provided he is given some reasonable time.

Since petitioner is ready and willing to deposit the entire amount of compensation awarded by the learned Court below, this Court sees no impediment in adjourning the case for six weeks, as prayed for by learned counsel for the petitioner, failing which this Court shall have no option but to decide the petition on its own merits.

List on 22.06.2026. In the meantime, 50% of the compensation amount lying deposited with the learned trial Court is ordered to be released in favour of the respondent, by remitting the same in its bank account, detail whereof, shall be furnished within a period of two days, if not already furnished.
