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05/12.06.2025 It appears from the report sent vide Letter No. 2078 dated 28.04.2025 by learned Member Secretary, JHALSA that mediation between the parties has failed.

2. Hence, the case be heard on its own merit.

3. I.A. No. 60 of 2025 has been filed on behalf of the petitioner under Rule 159 of High Court of Jharkhand Rules, 2001 seeking exemption from surrendering before the learned Court below.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is a lady and not able to pay more than Rs. 50,000/- at this stage and the petitioner is ready to deposit Demand Draft of Rs. 50,000/- in the name of the opposite party no. 2, without prejudice to her case, before the office of the learned Registrar General within one week from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the petitioner has already deposited Rs. 1,35,000/- before the during the pendency of the Appeal before

the learned Judicial Commissioner, Ranchi and as such, the petitioner may be exempting from surrendering before the learned Court below.

5. Under the circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to deposit Demand Draft of Rs. 50,000/- in the name of the opposite party no. 2, without prejudice to her case, before the office of the learned Registrar General within one week from today.

Learned Registrar General of this Court is directed to keep the said Demand Draft in safe custody and shall not disburse the same till further order of this Court.

6. Put up this case on 30.06.2025.

7. Interim order dated 27.02.2025 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court shall continue till 30.06.2025.

8. Let a copy of this order be sent to the Office of learned Registrar General for the needful.
