I.A No. 60 of 2025

I.A No. 60 of 2025 has been filed on behalf of the petitioner under Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules, 2001 for seeking exemption from surrendering before the learned Court below.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance of the order dated 12.06.2025, the petitioner has deposited a demand draft of Rs. 50,000/- in the name of O.P No. 2 before the office of the learned Registrar General. It is submitted that the petitioner has total deposited Rs. 1,85,000/- (Rs. One Lakh Eighty Five Thousand) till date and hence, the petitioner may be exempted from surrendering before the learned Court below.

3. Learned counsel for the O.P No. 2 has opposed the prayer and submitted that the learned Court below had directed the petitioner to pay a fine of Rs. 9,00,000/- (Rs. Nine Lakh) by way

of compensation.

4. Having heard learned counsel for both the sides and after going through the records of this case, it appears that this is a case of taking loan of Rs. 7,00,000/- (Rs. Seven Lakh) by the petitioner from the O.P No. 2 as per the complaint case.

5. As the petitioner has already deposited Rs. 1,85,000/- (Rs. One Lakh Eighty Five Thousand) and taking lenient view, the petitioner namely Rajni Srivastava is exempted from surrendering before the learned Court below.

6. Thus, I.A No. 60 of 2025 is allowed and stands disposed of.

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7. Call for the legible scanned copy of the Lower Court Records.

8. Put up this case on 12th August 2025.

9. In the meantime, it will open to the parties to seek instruction also on the point of compromise, if any.
