07/ 25.11.2025 I.A. No. 9715 of 2025 has been filed on behalf of the O.P.

No. 2 for release of the demand draft of Rs. 50,000/-, deposited by the petitioner before the learned Registrar General of this court, pursuant to the order passed by the co-ordinate bench.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the O.P. No. 2 submits that the matter is arising out of Section 138 of NI Act and the total compensation amount is Rs. 9 lakhs. He submits that Rs. 50,000/- has been deposited by the petitioner in terms of the order of the co-ordinate bench and in view of that the O.P. No. 2 may kindly be allowed to withdraw the said demand draft. He next submits that the O.P. No. 2 has already received Rs. 1,35,000/-, which was paid by the petitioner at the time of filing of the appeal before the learned first appellate court.

3. It has been pointed out that the validity period of the demand draft of Rs. 50,000/- as deposited by the petitioner before the learned Registrar General has already expired.

4. In view of the above, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner is directed to approach the learned Registrar General to take back the deposited demand draft of Rs. 50,000/- for its renewal within one week and after renewal, the same will be deposited again within one week thereafter with the learned Registrar General.

5. Learned counsel appearing for the O.P. No. 2 along with

complainant will approach the learned Registrar General of this court after two weeks and the learned Registrar General upon proper verification will hand over the re-validated demand draft of Rs. 50,000/- to the O.P. No. 2.

6. The aforementioned I.A. is allowed and disposed of.
7. Let this matter appear under the appropriate heading.
