08/30.07.2025 The present interlocutory application has been filed on behalf of the petitioners for substitution of the respondent no. 8 – Dhirendra Jaiswal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the respondent no. 8 has died during pendency of the writ petition on 21.07.2023. He left behind his widow and two sons as his heirs/legal representatives, whose descriptions have been given in paragraph nos. 3 and 4 of the present interlocutory application. Hence, they may be permitted to be substituted in place of the deceased respondent no. 8.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and for the reasons stated in the present interlocutory application, let the heirs/legal representatives of the deceased respondent no. 8, whose descriptions have been given in paragraph nos. 3 and 4 of the present interlocutory application be substituted in his place.

4. Let necessary substitution in the cause title of the writ petition be made by learned counsel for the petitioners in course of the day.

5. The present interlocutory application stands disposed

of.

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6. Issue notice to the newly impleaded respondent nos. 8(a), 8(b) & 8(c) under ordinary process for which requisites etc. must be filed within one week.

7. Put up this case under appropriate heading after six weeks.
