Counsel for the appellant and respondent nos. 1 to 4 and 7 to 9 are present.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that so far as other respondents are concerned, notice upon them either served personally or through their close relative except respondent no. 10, 13 and 14. He submits that the house of respondent nos. 10, 13 and 14 was found locked and therefore the notice could not be served. He submits that so far as other respondents are concerned the notice be accepted as validly served.

3. Considering the submissions, the notice upon respondent no. 5, 6, 11 and 12 is accepted as validly served. The respondent nos. 1 to 4 and 7 to 9 have already appeared.
