It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is aged about 71 years and is suffering from severe cognitive impairment including Dementia and Alzheimer. In support of the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner, several medical prescriptions have been brought on record which substantiate such submission.

On consideration of the age of the petitioner and the fact that he is suffering from Dementia as well as Alzheimer, the petitioner is exempted to surrender in connection with G.R. Case No.404 of 2006.
