1. I.A No.3104 of 2026 has been filed for adding Canara Bank through concerned Branch Manager, Naraina Vihar, Po & PS-New Delhi-110028 as respondent no.6.

2. After some argument, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner intends to not press I.A No.3104 of 2026.
