appearing for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Complaint
Case No.18932/2025, registered for the offence under Section 47(a)(b) of
Excise Act, pending in the Court of the learned C.J.M., Dhanbad.
3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that false
allegation is made against the petitioner. He further submits that the
petitioner is earning his livelihood by doing mason work in the city of
Bengaluru, however, the allegations are made of recovery of foreign liquor
from the house of the petitioner. He next submits that the petitioner is having
no criminal antecedent, as disclosed in paragraph 7 of this application.
4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and
submits that from the house of the petitioner, the said foreign liquor has been
recovered.
5. Considering that the petitioner is a mason and it has been pointed out
that he is working at Bengaluru and he has got no criminal antecedent, as
disclosed in paragraph 7 of this application and in that view of the matter, the
petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned Court within two weeks
from today and the learned Court shall release the petitioner on such terms
and conditions as the learned Court may deem fit and proper.
6. Accordingly, this application is disposed of.
