“i. For issuance of appropriate writ(s)/ order(s) /direction(s) direction particularly in the nature of mandamus directing Respondents to conduct a time-bound enquiry into the conduct and eligibility of Respondent No.8, Smt. Nirmala Soren, in respect of her compassionate appointment granted on account of the death of Late Sushil Kumar Besra.

AND/OR

ii. For issuance of appropriate writ(s) /order(s) / direction(s) direction particularly in the nature Certiorari for quashing and cancelling the compassionate appointment Respondent No.8 on the ground that she has violated the object of compassionate appointment by non-supporting and neglecting the deceased's dependent family. (Annexure-1))

AND/OR

iii. For issuance of appropriate writ(s)/ order(s) direction(s) /direction particularly in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider granting suitable benefits or fresh compassionate appointment, in favour of a suitable eligible family member among the genuine dependants of Late Sushil Kumar Besra.

AND/OR

iv. For issuance of appropriate writ(s)/ order(s) direction(s) /direction particularly in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to decide the petitioners' representations by a speaking and reasoned order within a stipulated time.”

2. After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with a liberty to the petitioners to workout their remedy in accordance with law because other forums are available for claiming maintenance.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent State is present and does not raise any objection.

4. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
