Heard Mr. Nawin Kumar, learned counsel appearing for the appellant and learned Spl.P.P.

This application has been preferred by the appellant for grant of provisional bail to him for a period of 10 days on account of death of his mother.

Post-mortem report has been brought on record from which it appears that mother of the appellant has died on 31.08.2025.

In view of the above therefore, we are inclined to admit the appellant on provisional bail for a period of 10 days. Accordingly, the appellant above named is directed to be released on provisional bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge cum Special Judge POCSO and Children Court, Simdega in connection with Simdega Mahila P.S. Case No.43 of 2018, subject to the condition that the appellant shall surrender before the learned trial court on or before 19th September 2025.

Let this case be listed under the heading for 'Orders' on 25th September, 2025 by which time the learned counsel for the appellant must file a supplementary affidavit bringing on record the surrender certificate of the appellant.

I.A. No. 12444 of 2025 stands allowed and disposed of.
