1. This Court has issued notice upon the respondent, as would be evident from order dated 17th March, 2026.
2. Pursuant thereto, notice was issued upon the respondent no. 1.
3. The service report of the notice has been received. The office note dated 5.5.2026 reflects that the notice sent through the ordinary process has been shown to be served through family members but jointness of the family has not been shown in service report, as per report of the process server kept at flag 'X'. So far notice sent through speed post is concerned, it has been reported by the postal peon to be 'insufficient address', the report of which is kept at flag 'Y'.
4. This Court, therefore, is of the view that notice is to be served through jurisdictional police station.
5. In view thereof, let Sr. Superintendent of Police, Ranchi be impleaded as party to the proceeding for this purpose.

6. Mr. Ratnesh Kumar, learned S.C. (L&C) I is being requested to waive notice on behalf of Sr. S.P., Ranchi.
7. Let the name of Mr. Ratnesh Kumar, learned S.C. (L&C) I be reflected in the cause list henceforth.
8. Learned counsel for the appellant undertakes to serve copy of memo of appeal upon Mr. Ratnesh Kumar, learned S.C. (L&C) I by tomorrow.
9. Let notice be issued upon the respondent through Sr. S.P., Bokaro, for which requisites etc. must be filed within a week.
10. Let affidavit be filed on behalf of Sr.S.P., Ranchi, showing service of notice upon respondent no. 1.
11. List this case on 18.06.2026.
