This interlocutory application has been preferred by the petitioner praying for exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

It seems that the foundation for making such prayer is that the petitioner is suffering from spleen abscess and in support of which, various medical prescriptions have been brought on record. However, a majority of the prescriptions relate to the year 2020 and the latest prescription is dated 03.02.2026 of MGM Medical College Hospital wherein the petitioner has been referred to a higher centre for better management.
