2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Sahibganj (M) P.S. Case No.100 of 2025 for the alleged offences registered under Sections 126(2), 109(1), 351(2), 352, 76 and 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 pending in the Court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sahibganj.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that there were enmities between the petitioners and informant earlier.

He further submits that there is allegation of firing, however, injury has not been received upon the body of anybody. He then submits that now a good sense has prevailed between the parties and they have compromised the matter and the said compromise petition has been brought on record by way of filing supplementary affidavit.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State submits that sections are not compoundable.

5. Considering that compromise has taken place between the parties and it has been pointed out that earlier enmities were there between both the sides and in that view of the matter the petitioners are directed to surrender before the learned Court within two weeks and the learned Court shall release the petitioners on such terms and conditions or the sureties as the learned Court may deem fit and proper.
