1. Heard the parties.
2. By filing this writ petition, the petitioner prays for a direction upon the Deputy Commissioner, Ranchi to issue the Character Certificate of the petitioner which is necessary in terms of PWD Code, as the petitioner is a Contractor. It is his case that without the Character Certificate, the petitioner cannot bid for any tenders, as mandated in the PWD Code.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already filed a representation before the Deputy Commissioner, Ranchi.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that if the petitioner files a fresh representation before the Deputy Commissioner, Ranchi, his case will be considered and an appropriate certificate will be issued.
5. Considering the said submission, I direct the petitioner to file a fresh representation within three from today, before the Deputy Commissioner, Ranchi, respondent No.2. The Deputy Commissioner, Ranchi, on receipt of the said representation will consider the case of the petitioner within three weeks and pass an appropriate order.
6. If it is found that the petitioner is entitled for the said

certificate, the same will be granted to him within a week thereafter.

7. With the aforesaid observations, this writ petition stands **disposed of.**
