Heard the learned counsel for the respective sides.

This application has been preferred by the petitioner for exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was directed to pay compensation of Rs.6,00,000/- by the learned trial Court, which was affirmed by the learned appellate Court. Learned counsel has further submitted that the land has been agreed to be transferred in the name of the opposite party no.2. Learned counsel has referred to an agreement entered into between the petitioner and the opposite party no.2.

Learned counsel for the opposite party no.2 has reiterated what has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner and has further stated that he does not have any objection to the prayer made by the petitioner for exemption to surrender especially in view of the compromise which has been effected between both the parties.

On consideration of the aforesaid fact, I am inclined to allow this application. Consequently, the petitioner is exempted to surrender in connection with Complaint Case No. 3679/2019.

I.A. stands disposed of.
