This application is directed against the order dated
12.12.2025 passed by the learned District & Additional Sessions Judge-I,
Khunti in Cr. Appeal No.19 of 2025 whereby and whereunder the order
dated 06.11.2025 passed by the learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile
Justice Board, Khunti in Torpa P.S. Case No.68 of 2024 rejecting the
prayer for bail of the petitioner has been affirmed.

It has been alleged that the informant had gone to attend a
fair with her husband but she returned early to attend to her livestock.
When her husband did not return, a search was conducted and after two
days the dead body of the husband of the informant was detected.

Submission has been advanced by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner is not named in the First Information Report
and his name has transpired in course of investigation when an unnamed
villager had disclosed that some persons including the present petitioner
were seen moving around the place of occurrence. Learned counsel
submits that another juvenile has been granted bail by a Coordinate
Bench of this Court in Cr. Revision No.762 of 2025. It has been
submitted that the petitioner is in remand home since 26.11.2024.

Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail of the
petitioner.

Regard being had to the manner of implication of the
petitioner and the fact that one of the co-accused similarly situated
having been granted bail, while setting aside the order dated 12.12.2025

passed by the learned District & Additional Sessions Judge-I, Khunti in Cr. Appeal No.19 of 2025 and the order dated 06.11.2025 passed by the learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Khunti in connection with Torpa P.S. Case No.68 of 2024, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Khunti in connection with Torpa P.S. Case No.68 of 2024, subject to the condition that the sister of the petitioner shall ensure the safety of the petitioner and shall not allow him to mingle with any anti-social elements.

This revision application stands allowed.
