**1.** The descriptions of the land are as follows:-

“An area of 81 decimals of plot no.143 under Khata No.438, an area of 73 decimals of Plot No.146 under Khata No.438, an area of 1.06 acres of plot No.150 under Khata No.438, an area of 86 decimals of plot No.153 under Khata No.438, mauza Kapali, Thana No.332”

**2.** The primary issue involved in the present case is whether the land in question is a tribal land and whether it is covered under the provisions of Section 46 of the Chhotanagpur Tenancy Act, 1908.

**3.** Learned counsel for the State is directed to file a specific affidavit, bringing on record all relevant and necessary documents pertaining to the nature and status of the land in question.

**4.** As prayed for, put up this case after four weeks.
