1. Heard the parties.
2. The present writ petition has been filed for the following reliefs:-
 - “i. For passing of appropriate writ/writs/ directions to the respondent i.e. Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Election officer, Saraiekela Kharsawan to prepare revised electoral roll in reference to S. 14 (b) of the Representation of the People Act, 1950 which is due since 1 January 2026, for the Saraikella Constituency
 - ii. To direct the respondent Deputy Commissioner- cum District Election officer, Saraiekela Kharsawan or any other designated officer to prepare revised electoral roll in reference to S. 14 (b) of the Representation of the People Act, 1950 as per latest qualifying date i.e. 1 January 2026 in view of upcoming Adityapur municipal corporation election.”
3. After some argument, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with a liberty to work out his remedy in accordance with law.

4. Learned counsel for the other sides have raised no objection.
5. Permission is accorded.
6. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
