2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. 433/2024 for the offence under section 379/498A/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, pending in the court of Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Deoghar.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner happened to be the husband of the informant and there are general and omnibus allegation of torture and demand of dowry and the complaint case has been lodged arraying all the family members as accused.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that the case is arising out of complaint Case.

5. Considering that the matter is arising out of complaint case and the all the family members have been implicated in this case, there are general and omnibus allegation and the petitioner happened to be

the husband of the informant, in that view of the matter, the petitioner above named is directed to surrender before the learned Court within two weeks and the learned Court shall release the petitioner on such terms and condition or sureties, the learned Court may deem fit and proper.
