2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No. 98/2024, registered for the offences under sections 341/323/353/504/506 of the Indian Penal Code, pending in the Court learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chatra.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that false allegation is made against the petitioners of entering into the altercation with the informant. He also submits that no injury is there. He further submits that the petitioners are having no criminal antecedents as disclosed in Para 11 of the petition.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that the allegation of altercation is there.

5. Considering that, on spur of the moment, the altercation took place, there is no injury on the body of the informant and the petitioners are having no criminal antecedents as disclosed in Para 11 of the petition. In that view of the matter, the petitioners above

named are directed to surrender before the learned Court within two weeks and the learned Court shall release the petitioners on such terms and condition or sureties, the learned Court may deem fit and proper.
