Post-mortem report of the deceased-Kherun Nisha suggests that a few external antemortem injuries were found on her body, which were caused by hard and blunt force; however, according to the doctor, the said injuries were not sufficient to cause death in the ordinary course of nature. It has further been mentioned that the opinion with respect to the cause of the death has been reserved till availability of report of chemical analysis of viscera and histopathological examination of the deceased.
