- Learned senior counsel for the petitioner seeks adjournment. He submits that the matter be posted in the next week.
- However, during the course of preliminary argument, the learned senior counsel for the petitioner has submitted that one of the points which may fall for consideration before this Court is whether second application under Section 319 Cr. P.C. was maintainable when there was no change in the stage of the case or any circumstance.
- Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the opposite party no. 2 has submitted that the petition under section 319 of the Cr. P.C. at the earlier stage was not dismissed on merits, rather the court refused to entertain the same. Subsequently upon furnishing of supplementary charge sheet and on the basis of evidences brought on record including the evidences of the eye witness of the occurrence, the petitioner has been made accused by the impugned order.
