the petitioner and learned A.P.P.

This application is directed against the judgment  
dated 01.12.2025 passed by the learned Additional Sessions  
Judge-I-cum-Spl. Judge, Children Court, Gumla in connection  
with Criminal Appeal No. 37/2025, whereby and whereunder,  
the order dated 13.05.2025 passed by the learned Principal  
Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Gumla in connection with  
Dumri P.S. Case No. 10/2025 rejecting the prayer for bail of the  
petitioner has been affirmed.

Submission has been advanced by the learned  
counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since  
10.03.2025. It has further been submitted that the father of the  
petitioner, who is an agriculturist shall take care of the  
petitioner and shall ensure that the petitioner does not have  
any company with anti-social elements. Learned counsel has  
further submitted that so far as the antecedent of the petitioner  
is concerned, he has already been acquitted in the same.

Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail of the  
petitioner.

It appears from the allegations that the petitioner  
had enticed away the daughter of the informant for the

purposes of marriage. Considering the fact that the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent and the period of custody undergone by him apart from the undertaking given by the father, while setting aside the judgment dated 01.12.2025 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-I-cum-Spl. Judge, Children Court, Gumla in connection with Criminal Appeal No. 37/2025 and the order dated 13.05.2025 passed by the learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Gumla in connection with Dumri P.S. Case No. 10/2025 direct that the petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) only with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Gumla in connection with Dumri P.S. Case No. 10/2025, subject to the condition that the father of the petitioner shall ensure the safe keep of the petitioner and shall also ensure that the petitioner is kept away from anti-social elements.

This application stands allowed.
