1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. Mr. Manoj Tandon, the learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, seeks leave to withdraw this petition with liberty to file a representation within ten days for refund of the forfeited earnest money. He submits that some directions may be issued to the 5th respondent for disposal of his representation in accordance with law and on its own merits.

3. Mr. Tandon, refers to the order dated 25.03.2026 disposing of W.P. (C) No. 1783 of 2026 filed by Samarth Ad Protex Private Limited, who was the other tenderer in respect of the same sand ghat. He submits that similar liberty was granted to the said petitioner.

4. Considering the order passed disposing of W.P.(C) No. 1783 of 2026, we grant the petitioner leave to withdraw this petition with liberty to represent to the 5th respondent for refund of the forfeited earnest money.

5. If the representation is filed within 10 days from today, the 5th respondent should dispose it of in accordance with law and on its own merits within eight weeks from its receipt after hearing the petitioner and passing a reasoned order. All contentions of all parties are however left open to be decided by the 5th respondent at the first instance.

6. The petition is allowed to be withdrawn with liberty in the above terms and without any order for costs.

7. Pending Interlocutory Applications, if any, do not survive and are disposed of.
