This interlocutory application has been preferred to substitute the original petitioner – Vishwa Nath Mishra, who died on 24.06.2025 i.e. during pendency of this Contempt Petition.

2. Considering the main contempt case, which has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 22.10.2024 passed in W.P.(S) No.6091 of 2022, and since the petitioner has passed away during pendency of the contempt case, I am of the opinion that the cause of action survives and devolves upon the legal heirs of the deceased petitioner. Thus, it is necessary to substitute the deceased petitioner – Vishwa Nath Mishra, by his legal heir namely :-

“Rohit Rakesh, S/o Vishwanath Mishra, R/ House No.145/2/3, Road No.13, Adityapur 1, near Housing Office, P.O. & P.S. Adityapur, District Saraikela Kharsawan (Jharkhand).”

3. Accordingly, this interlocutory application stands **allowed**. The above named legal heir (son) of the deceased petitioner - Vishwa Nath Mishra is impleaded as party to the contempt petition and the name of the original petitioner be deleted.

4. Necessary corrections be made in the cause title in red

ink.

- 5.** Learned counsel representing the petitioner will also file one typed copy of fresh amended cause title page, within two weeks.
