2. So far as the prayer made by the petitioner in para 1(i) and para 1(ii) of the writ petition is concerned, it has been fairly submitted that the grievance has been redressed as the entire retiral benefit has been paid and the petitioner is now getting the pension.

3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that this petitioner after the death of his first wife has married to Meena Devi. Thus, the name of Meena Devi should be entered in the documents of the petitioner maintained by the respondents for future need.

4. Considering the said submission, I direct the petitioner to file a fresh representation annexing all the documents, before the respondents and on receipt of such representation, the respondents will consider the representation and only after being satisfied that the marriage has taken place after the death of his first wife, the respondents will take appropriate decision in this matter.

5. With the aforesaid directions, this writ petition stands disposed of.
