2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. 2330 of 2024, registered for the offence under Section 85 of the BNS and under Section 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, pending in the Court of the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Hazaribagh.
3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner happened to be the husband of the complainant and the case has been filed under Section 85 of the BNS and under Section 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act. He further submits that there are general and omnibus allegation of torture and demand of dowry and the complaint case has been lodged against all the family members. He then submits that the learned Court has been pleased to take cognizance. He also submits that the petitioner has filed the restitution case before the Family Court, Koderma being Original Suit No. 116 of 2023 and the ex-parte decree was granted and thereafter, the present Complaint Case has been lodged.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that the case is arising out of the Complaint Case.

5. Considering that the petitioner is the husband and he has filed the Original Suit No. 116 of 2023 and the decree has been passed in his favour ex-parte and, thereafter, the present complaint case has been filed against the petitioner and in that view of the matter, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned Court within two weeks from today and the learned Court shall release the petitioner on such terms and conditions as the learned Court may deem fit and proper.

6. Accordingly, this application is disposed of.
