2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Cyber P.S. Case No.172 of 2025 for the alleged offences registered under Sections 318(4) and 336(3) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Sections 66(C) and 66(D) of I.T. Act pending in the Court of learned A.J.C.-II-cum-Special Judge, Cyber Crime, Ranchi.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and the allegations are made that certain amount has been transferred in the account of the petitioner from mobile of the victim/informant.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State submits that Rs.90,000/- has been transferred in the account of the petitioner from UPI by using mobile of the victim/informant.

5. Considering that the said amount has been credited in the account of the petitioner from mobile of the victim/informant by way of utilizing UPI, I am not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, hence, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is hereby rejected. However, if the petitioner surrenders before the learned Court the same will be considered by the learned Court in accordance with law without prejudice to this order.
