It appears that due to mistake on the part of P.A. concerned Social Investigation Report of the petitioner has been called for vide order dated 05.03.2025 which is modified to the extend no such Social Investigation Report of the petitioner is required in this case as described in the paragraph 3 of order dated 05.03.2025.

2. It appears from the office note that notice has been issued and undelivered register cover with AD has been received so far in respect of the O.P. No. 2.

3. It also appears from report send by Miss Kusum Kumari the learned District & Additional Sessions Judge –I – cum- Special Judge FTC , Ramgarh in letter No. 84/25 dated 03.03.2025 , by which it has been informed that the case is fixed for framing of charges .

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the police has submitted final form against the petitioner and even the Victim girl has not supported the allegation against the petitioner during her statement recorded under section 164 of Cr.P.C. and as such the discharge petition has been wrongly rejected by the learned Court below.

5. Learned A.P.P. is directed to file the counter affidavit.

6. Put up this case on 24.06.2025 and till then further proceeding against the petitioner shall remain stayed in connection with S.T. Case No. 68 of 2023 corresponding to MCA No. 188 of 2023 arising out of Patratu (Bhadaninagar) P.S. Case No. 08 of 2023 presently pending in the Court of Additional Sessions Judge I-cum-Special Judge, FTC, Ramgarh.
