Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the interlocutory application has been filed with the prayer for impleading the complainant as opposite party no.2 of this Cr.M.P. It is next submitted that the one of the offences involved in this case is punishable under the penal provisions of S.C. & S.T. (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, hence, complainant, whose name, parentage and address has been mentioned in para-07 of this interlocutory application, is required to be impleaded as opposite party no.2 in this Cr.M.P.. It is lastly submitted that the prayer as prayed for in this interlocutory application be allowed.
