2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Dumka (M)
P.S. Case No. 159 of 2025, registered under sections 190, 191(2), 191(3), 115(2), 109,
308(3), 308(4), 331(6), 351(3), 352 of BNS and section 27 of the Arms Act,, pending
in the Court of learned C.J.M, Dumka.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that only allegation is made
of firing however injury has not been received by anyone. He next submits that first
incident is said to be taken place on 29.11.2025 however F.I.R has been lodged on
01.12.2025. He next submits that false allegation has been made of going in a hotel
and demanding money. On these grounds, he submits that the petitioners may kindly
be provided privilege of anticipatory bail.

4. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer and submits that
allegations are there of firing.

5. Considering that first incident is said to be taken place on 29.11.2025
however F.I.R has been lodged on 01.12.2025 further allegations are there of firing
however injury has not been received by anyone and in that view of the matter,
petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned court within two weeks from
today and the learned court shall release the petitioners on terms and conditions and
sureties as learned court deems fit and proper.

6. This anticipatory bail application is disposed of.
