It has been submitted by Mr. Sanjoy Piprawall, that one case is pending before the Hon'ble Apex Court on similar issue; as such, these cases may be taken up after the disposal of the case pending before the Hon'ble Apex Court, which has been disputed by Ld. Sr. Counsel for the Petitioners.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and after going through the rival contention of the parties the following issues are involved for proper determination of the case:

Issue No.1-Whether the process of Normalization for Para Teacher/Non Para

Teacher has been done separately?

Issue No.2- Whether the normalization process has been applied including 50000 and odd candidates whose candidature were rejected vide notification dated 13.05.2025?

Issue No. 3- Whether the questions of all the sets of each subject in written examination pursuant to the advertisement no. 13/2023 were different?

Issue No.4- On how many dates and in how many shifts was the examination conducted in Computer-Based Test (CBT) mode?

Issue No.5- What parameters were adopted for the normalization process, and how were the normalized marks calculated?

Issue No.6- Whether the process of normalisation has been applied uniformly to all combinations of subjects in Paper-IV?

Issue No.7- Whether the process of normalisation has been applied in the Language Papers for Classes VI to VIII?

Issue No. 8- Whether the respondents have adopted different methodologies for determining the qualifying status of the candidates and preparation of the final merit list?

Mr. Sanjoy Piprawall, learned counsel representing the respondent-commission is directed to seek instruction and file an affidavit on the issues raised hereinabove
