02/ 11.02.2026: Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Ramna P.S. Case No. 127 of 2025 registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(2), 351(2), (3), 352, 3(5) of BNS, pending in the Court of learned J.M. Ist Class, Garhwa.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners and informant are agnates and altercation took place due to harvesting of the crops. He next submits that there are case and counter case between the parties. He further submits that there are general and omnibus allegations against all the accused persons and petitioners have got no criminal antecedent which is disclosed in para 6 of the petition. On these grounds, he submits that the petitioners may kindly be provided privilege of anticipatory bail.

4. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer and submits that allegations of assault are there.

5. Considering that petitioners and informant are agnates, there are case and counter case between the parties and petitioners have got no criminal antecedent which is disclosed in para 6 of the petition, I am inclined

to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, the above named, petitioners are directed to surrender before the learned court within three weeks from today and in the event of their surrender / arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000/- (twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned J.M. Ist Class, Garhwa, in connection with Ramna P.S. Case No. 127 of 2025, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S, 2023.
