2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection
with Mahagama P.S. Case No. 198 of 2025, registered for the offence
under Sections 115(2)/118(2)/126(2)/127(2) /331(4)/190/191(2) /191(3)
/303(2)/61(2)/76 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, pending in the
court of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Godda.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that
there are general and omnibus allegations against these petitioners of
making assault due to old enmity and further the petitioners are having
no criminal antecedent and disclosure to that effect has been made in
para-16 of the petition.

4. Learned A.P.P. appearing for the State has opposed the
prayer and submits that the allegations are there of making assault.

5. Looking into the contents of the FIR, it transpires that there
is direct allegation of making assault against one Sangram Hansda by a
lathi and outraging the modesty of the wife of the informant and so far

as these petitioners are concerned, there are general and omnibus allegations against them, in that view of the matter, the petitioners, named above, are directed to surrender before the learned Court within two weeks from today and the learned Court shall release the petitioners on such terms and conditions or the sureties as the learned Court may deem fit and proper.
