02/13.02.2026 Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and learned counsel appearing for the State.

2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Jamua P.S. Case No.280/2025, registered for the offence under Sections 190, 191(3), 324(4), 109, 126(2), 351(2) of the BNS and Section 27 of Arms Act, pending in the Court of the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Giridih.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the case. He further submits that there is allegation against 100 unknown persons and 24 named persons of going on the spot where the work was being conducted by the labourers and interfering and assault. He then submits that there are general and omnibus allegations of assault. He next submits that the petitioners are having no criminal antecedent, as disclosed in paragraph 6 of this application. On these grounds, he submits that anticipatory bail may kindly be granted to the petitioners.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that the allegations are there of going on the spot and assault.

5. Looking into the contents of the FIR, it transpires that the allegations are there against one Md. Khora Raja, who has fired and that allegation is not against these petitioners. The allegation is made against 24 named persons and 100 unknown persons. The petitioners are having no criminal antecedent.

6. In that view of the matter, the petitioners are directed to surrender before the learned Court within two weeks from today and the learned Court shall release the petitioners on such terms and conditions as the learned Court may deem fit and proper.

7. Accordingly, this application is disposed of.
