This anticipatory bail application under Sections 482 & 484 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023, has been preferred by the petitioner apprehending her arrest for offences registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120B of the Indian Penal Code pending in the court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jamshedpur, in connection with Sakchi PS Case No. 171 of 2023 corresponding to GR No. 1879 of 2023.

3. Heard, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

4. Earlier on 12.06.2025, the anticipatory bail application of the petitioner was dismissed on merit.

5. The laptops and some others documents were recovered from the premises of the petitioner where forged marksheets and documents of the Universities were being prepared by other accused persons. The accused apprehended have stated that they were working under the direction and guidance of this petitioner. On this ground, the earlier anticipatory bail application was rejected. Now the petitioner again filed anticipatory bail application taking a plea that she does not reside in Jamshedpur where the occurrence had taken place. This is not a ground to reconsider the anticipatory bail application. In fact, the petitioner is seeking a review of the earlier order on facts, which is impermissible.

6. In view of the aforesaid fact, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in connection with Sakchi PS Case No. 171 of 2023 corresponding to GR No. 1879 of 2023, pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jamshedpur, stands rejected.

7. Accordingly, the instant anticipatory bail application stands dismissed.
