02/07.05.2026 Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as learned counsel appearing for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Kunda P.S. Case No.198 of 2025, for the alleged offences registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 109(1), 85, 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Deoghar.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner happened to be husband of the informant and the allegations are made that when wife has requested to remove the motorcycle in front of the house of one of the person the petitioner has assaulter her. He further submits that the entire family members have been made accused, however, the other in-laws have been granted anticipatory bail by learned Sessions Judge. He then

submits that even the injury is said to be simple. On these grounds, he submits that anticipatory bail may kindly be granted.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that the petitioner has assaulted the wife and in view of that anticipatory bail may kindly be rejected.

5. Considering that the scuffle took place between the husband and wife for a trivial issue of removing the motorcycle in front of house of another person and in-laws have been granted anticipatory bail by learned Sessions Judge and the injury is said to be simple, I am inclined to provide anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is hereby directed to surrender before the learned Court within three weeks from today, and in the event of his surrender/arrest, the petitioner, above named, shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand), with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Deoghar in connection with Kunda P.S. Case No.198 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
