1. Heard the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has surrendered before the court on 05.12.2025 and the name of the petitioner has transpired in the confessional statement of co-accused namely Rizwan Alam, who has been enlarged on bail.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there has been no TIP and no recovery from the possession of the petitioner.
4. Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer and submitted that the petitioner has seven criminal antecedents.
5. Learned counsel for the State has also submitted that TIP was conducted, but the chart is not available in the case diary.
6. Learned counsel for the State is directed to file a supplementary counter affidavit bringing on record the TIP chart and specifically stating as to whether the petitioner has been identified and whether there is any recovery from the possession of the petitioner or on the basis of confessional statement of the petitioner.
